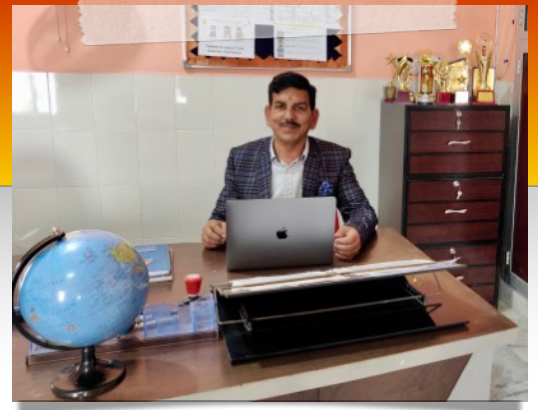

It is an English-medium co-educational school affiliated with the Central Board of Secondary Education, New Delhi up to class 12th.

The establishment of the school was inspired by Late Mrs Indra Joshi who was a proponent of women's education and wanted to establish a school to provide quality education to the village people.

CURRICULUM

The School follows curriculum in strict accordance with CBSE, New Delhi.

Pre Primary and Primary Classes

- All the learning takes place in a fun and enjoyable way, where the children learn through playful activities & value-based learning is emphasised.
- The importance of values is kept in mind while preparing and designing the lessons.
- The day begins with the morning assembly - where prayers, rhymes, exercises and celebration of special days is conducted.
- The students are graded regularly on the basis of participation and performance in the class activities.
- Evaluation is done on the basis of individual growth and development of the child

Senior and Senior Secondary Classes

- The branches introduced in class 11th are PCM, PCB and commerce.
- Technology is extensively used in the day to day teaching in the classrooms.
- The theoretical knowledge gained in class is also put into use in the practical labs.
- The students are also provided with vocational courses to upskill them for the future.
- The promotion of students to the next class is strictly based on weightage prescribed by CBSE.
- The medium of instruction in class is English.
- Periodic progress reports are sent to the parents throughout the year.

Facilities

Laboratories

Science comes alive in the lab. It is almost impossible to fully understand the subject of science without the concept of show and tell. Laboratory experiments make students more curious and intrigued by the subject.

Laboratories help students understand specific theories and facts in science. Through laboratory experiences, a student can begin questioning certain scientific concepts. They can go ahead and come up with experiments that support their arguments, which can lead to new scientific discoveries.

Sports and Games

Indoor facilities include chess, carrom and table tennis. Outdoor facilities include Basketball, Volleyball, kho-kho, Badminton, etc.



Yoga/Gymnastics

Gymnastics is an all-encompassing exercise program that incorporates strength, speed, power, coordination, flexibility, and balance.

It is a foundation sport that develops the child's ability for all the later sporting pursuits and is also a heap of fun! We provide them with this chance to use all their enthusiasm and energy to explore their potential with important basic skills.

Besides it, yoga is also taught to the students.



Educational Tours

Educational tours play a very important role in educating students practically and engagingly. Something that is seen in real can be more easily perceived than something that we simply read in a book.

From time to time educational tours are conducted for the students. They are very effective in teaching the child the values of sharing & caring for others and being happy in any environment he/she is in. They learn by seeing, it also makes learning much more interesting.



Health and Hygiene

As we know that a healthy mind resides in a healthy body, so great stress is laid on physical exercise to keep our body healthy and sound.

Proper sanitation and hygiene habits are also taught to the children and they are informed about its importance starting at the very early age. Doctors visit the school and conduct medical checkup on the students. The students' nails, teeth, hair etc. are checked by the teachers.



Social Campaigns and Drives

We believe in order to make a difference in society, mere theoretical and academic knowledge is not sufficient, the students need to understand and analyse how their efforts can change the world and they become the leaders of tomorrow. So in order to facilitate this, the school organises various campaign drives on different social aspects to create awareness among the people.

House Division

Admission Process

The branches introduced in class XI are PCM, PCB and Commerce.

The school have strived to make the admission process as simple as possible to ensure that all prospective parents enjoy a stress free application experience. Admissions are held as per the CBSE guidelines in the month of April for which Registration should be done in the month of March onwards.

Children seeking admission to classes I to XI will have to go through a qualifying test in English, Mathematics, Science, and Social Studies.

Following Documents are required at the time of admission: -

1. Xerox copy of Date of Birth Certificate.
2. Xerox Copy of UID (AADHAR).
3. Transfer Certificate from the institution last attended.
4. Extra-curricular records or achievement certificates, if any.
5. Character Certificate from the institution last attended.
6. Passport size photograph of the student.

Please arrive with the mentioned documents at the school office.

Withdrawal

Parents wanting to withdraw their child must give one month notice in written in the school office in advance. Only then the withdrawal will be accepted by the school. If the child is to be withdrawn from 1st April, notice of withdrawal must be received by the school by 1st March positively. If the notice is given in April, the fee of month of May and June will be charged.

Transfer certificate will be issued only after clearing of all dues in the school.

SCHOOL TIMINGS

○ Winter (4th week of October to 4th week of March) :

Pre-primary: 8:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.

Class 1st to 12th: 8:30 a.m. to 2:10 p.m.



School Rules and Guidelines

The student must reach the school 10 mins before the school assembly.

All students are expected to come in proper tidy school uniform.

Parents are not allowed to see their ward during the school hours.

Fee must be paid before 10th of every month from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m., a fine of Rs.20/-per week will be charged for the dates overdue including holidays.

No student will be allowed to sit in the exam without clearing dues if any.

PTM is held every month to discuss the child's progress. Suggestions for improvement from both the sides are entertained.

No student is permitted to bring two wheelers in school.

The students must submit the leave application to the class teacher for taking any leave.

Parents are earnestly requested to send their wards to the school regularly. They are requested to cooperate with the school in sending their ward to the school in proper tidy uniform.

The students are not required to bring expensive belongings and mobile phones to the school.

The students will be responsible for the safe custody of their items and belongings.

Parents/Students are expected to behave in a courteous and polite manner to the school staff.

No student is allowed to leave or change the school without one month prior notice to the school. All dues should also be cleared before taking TC.

Parents are required to park their vehicle outside the school gate. No parent vehicle is permitted inside the school premises.

Parents need to give written permission to the school before leaving or starting the bus facility, one month before in advance.

FEES AND PAYMENT

- Annual and ECA fee will be charged once a year in April
- Examination fee will be charged twice a year in 2nd and 4th quarter.
- Lab charge will be charged 9th onwards.
- Tuition and bus fee will be charged for all 12 months.
- No student will be allowed to appear in the examination if total dues are not cleared.
- Written application for bus withdrawal should be given to school one month in advance, otherwise full fee would be charged.
- If quarterly fee is not paid on time then fine would be charged at Rs.10 per week.
